JET SKI-ING RESTRICTIONS AND LAUNCHING OF SMALL BOATS

SCARBOROUGH

Jet Skis are not permitted in the South Bay.

On the North Bay, motor vehicles must be left in the parking areas and not driven or parked on the slipways or beach. It is permissible to un-hitch a trailer and wheel it down the slipway on to the beach.. Jet Ski-ing is not permitted within 200 metres of the tide line, or within 200 metres of any swimmers, surfers or other water users.

FILEY

Jet Ski-ing is not permitted off Filey.

WHITBY

Jet Ski-ing is permitted only from Upgang Ravine.

BRIDLINGTON

Jet Ski-ing is permitted only from the boat compound on the South Shore. A tractor is available to assist in taking trailers to the tide line.

LAUNCHING OF SMALL BOATS AT SCARBOROUGH HARBOUR

Small boats and dinghies may be launched from the Golden Ball Slipway. To do this it is necessary to contact Port Control at the end of the West Pier either in person or by telephone 01723 373877, they will authorise the launching. The cost is £11.99 inclusive of VAT.

Small boats can be launched from Filey. Permits can be bought from Baker's Café on the Cobble Landing. Owner is Charles Baker. Permits are £10.00 per day. Café is open daily between 09.00 – 17.00. Tel: 01723 514056.
